offer many different opportunities for involvement for children, teenagers, men, women and senior adults. We invite you to become a part of our family!

Sunday Bible Study gives persons of every age the opportunity to study the Bible together. Fourteen different classes for kids, students and adults meet each Sunday at 9:00 am to learn what the Bible says and apply it to life. There’s a class for you. Join us!

Kid’s Korner Children’s Ministry is designed to help families raise children in a Christian manner. EMBC provides a fun & safe environment while encouraging children to grow in the grace of our Lord. Activities include Bible Study, Choirs, Missions (R.A.’s, G.A.’s, Mission Friends) and special events.

Thru-The-Roof Student Ministry is for students in grades 7-12. This ministry provides an atmosphere of worship, fellowship and service. Meeting weekly for Bible Study, worship and service is important for this group of teens.

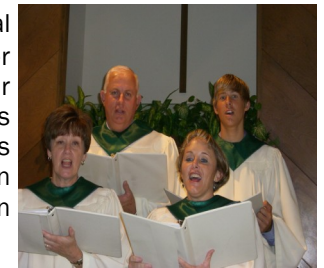
Men on Mission & Women on Mission (*Hearts to Hands* and *Camilla Propst Groups*) meet monthly and are involved in missions through prayer, study, service and giving.

Senior Adults meet for lunch each month and enjoy times of worship, interesting programs and occasional trips together. They welcome anyone 55 and older.

Worship is a vital part of our life together at East Maiden. Our choir ministry gives everyone opportunities to exercise God-given abilities in Christian service.



Children’s Choirs help teach the fundamentals of music and also provide experience in leading worship through music. All of these choirs meet on Wednesday nights (September–May) at 6:00. These choirs include:

Preschool Choir is for kids 3–K to learn to enjoy music, occasionally singing for others.

Younger Children’s Choir is for school-aged children grades 1-3 who are learning more challenging music and also sing occasionally for Sunday morning worship.

Older Children’s Choir is for school-aged children in grades 4-6 who regularly sing for worship.

Youth Choir is made up of teenagers from Thru-The-Roof Student Ministry. The music consists of contemporary worship music. This choir meets on Sunday evenings at 6:30.

EMBC Choir is our 25 voice adult choir. This choir rehearses Wednesday nights at 7:40 to prepare for Sunday worship. They present two musicals during the year: an Easter Worship Experience and a Christmas Eve Celebration.
